Academic Details

Sipajhar College continues to provide diverse academic opportunities catering to the educational needs of students at different levels. The college offers a two-year Higher Secondary Course in Arts under the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. Presently the college has thirteen departments under two streams (Science & Arts) having PG Course in two departments (Assamese & English) under Gauhati University along with newly introduced ITEP course from the next session.

The Central Library of the college is fully computerized and operates using SOUL 2.0 software for the efficient management of acquisition, cataloguing, circulation, and Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) services. The library also maintains a digital repository through DSpace software, which preserves and provides access to institutional publications such as college magazines, journals, seminar proceedings, question papers, and class notes. The library provides access to a wide range of e-resources through the One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) initiative, enabling students and faculty members to access scholarly content and digital learning materials. To support academic and research activities, the library offers modern facilities and services, including:



Students' Reading Room

- A collection of more than 24,000 books, 15 periodicals, and 6 newspapers, including The Hindu in online mode.
- Fifteen internet-enabled computers for students.
- An online attendance system.
- OPAC facility for easy search and retrieval of library resources.
- Online registration and feedback systems for users.
- An exclusive Competitive Examination Corner with over 300 books covering various competitive examinations.

Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University (KKHSOU) study centre, Sipajhar College currently offers undergraduate courses in 11 departments, postgraduate courses in 7 departments, and 4 diploma courses. In the year 2025, a total of 187 students were enrolled in various programmes under the study centre.

The **Computer Centre**, Sipajhar College offers PGDCA, a two-year diploma course in Computer Application, helping students develop technical and professional skills

Certificate Courses

During the academic session 2025–26, the college did eight add-on courses to enhance students' skills and practical knowledge beyond the classroom. These included (a) **Communicative English** (b) **Computer Application** (c) **Computer Hardware** (d) **Digital Photography** (e) **Mushroom Cultivation** (f) **Plastic Waste Management** (g) **Typesetting in LaTeX**, and (h) **Vermicomposting & Vermiculture** conducted by various departments. Students have not only gained knowledge but also translated their skills into meaningful livelihoods. A total of 137 students are enrolled in these courses for the current session.



Mushroom Cultivation

- Through the course on vermicomposting and vermiculture, students have successfully produced and sold significant quantities of organic fertilizer, creating a sustainable source of income.
- Jintu Nath, a certified participant of the Digital Photography course, advanced his training to a professional level and is now self-employed in the field.
- Akhil Sarma, trained in Mushroom Cultivation, has embraced the discipline as a pathway to self-employment, turning expertise into enterprise.

- Sipajhar College Competitive Examination Society – Formed to guide and motivate students preparing for various competitive examinations through academic support, counselling, and awareness programmes.



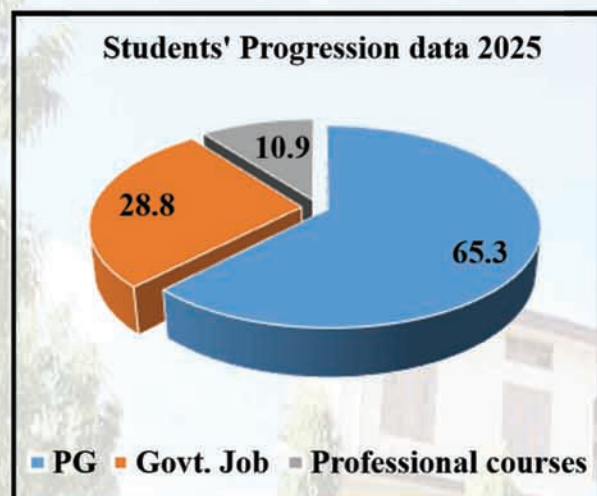
